Today we were going over the CAT Production System (yes, they are trying to be like Toyota) and I was the only one in the room of 29 new hires with engineering or supply chain degrees from Michigan State, U of Illinois, Penn State, Iowa State, and a bunch of other schools who knew what lean was, had read The Goal, knew what Kanban was, and knew anything about the concepts of swift even flow and uncertainty in a supply chain. All of these concepts I learned in your OPS program. And it's not like everyone just wasn't participating because the speakers would just ask "Has anyone read The Goal" or "Who knows what a Kanban System is?" and I was one of two people or the only one who could say I knew what they were talking about. Also, the logistics new hires (2 Supply Chain Grads from Penn State) were all excited because they get to get APICS certified but didn't even know what APICS was until yesterday.

Basically, your OPS program is awesome. I know you know that and I knew that as well but this past week has just re-enforced that and I just wanted to share that story with you.

Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP)

The CSCP program is a new industry educational and certification program created to meet the rapidly changing needs of the supply chain management field. The CSCP program takes a broad view of the field, extending beyond internal operations to encompass all the steps throughout the supply chain – from supplier, through the customer to the end consumer – and provides you with the knowledge to effectively manage the integration of activities to maximize a company's value chain. Eligibility requirements for the exam include having a bachelors degree, or one of the following certifications; CPIM, CIRM and C.P.M., or 5 years of supply chain experience.

Lean Enterprise Workshop

The new APICS Lean Enterprise Workshop is a program that covers the following topics:

1. **Introduction to Lean:** Educate the Organization, Assess Readiness and Define Product Families
2. **Lean Culture:** Plan for Change, Create Teams and Choosing a Product Family
3. **Value Stream Mapping:** Map Current Value Stream, Map Future State, Plan the Implementation
4. **Process Stability and Process Improvement:** How to Stabilize Demand and Processes then Improve Them
5. **Just-In-Time:** Calculate Customer Demand, Standardize Work, Create Flow, Implement Pull and Develop Schedules
6. **Measuring:** Define Lean Metrics, Deploy Lean Accounting
7. **Sustaining:** Design for Lean, Continuously Improve Quality and Sustain the Lean Environment

Participants in the workshop will conduct analyses of issues such as increased lead times and excess inventory. They will participate in kaizen exercises, map the value stream and draft a lean implementation plan for their own organizations. The program incorporates a variety of tools, games and visual aides utilizing a case study approach which spans all modules. The participants will:

1. Complete a self assessment to determine their organization's readiness to implement Lean.
2. Gain practical experience analyzing how to incorporate Lean into organizations.
3. Obtain broad knowledge of the subject.
4. Leave with a project plan for implementing lean into their organization.
